

Huron Heat Female Girls Association 2016/2017

The Huron Heat Female Hockey Association is pleased to present our registration information package which contains the most pertinent information regarding hockey registration for the 2016/2017 season.

Registration

A completed registration includes:

- 1) Registration form,
- 2) Payment / Tryout Fee
- 3) Birth certificate for first time players

The registration nights are as follows;

March 22 & 23 in the Blyth Arena from 7-8:30 pm

March 31 in the Clinton Arena from 6-8:00 pm

April 13 in the Hensall Arena from 6:-7:00 pm

Registration will also be available at all tryout dates – April 14, 17, 18, 20, 23, 24, & 30th (Times and arenas posted on the Huron Heat website)

Fee Structure

There are 2 registration levels available to all teams in all divisions except the fundamentals program.

The Tier II fee will include ice time, ref fees for the season, team and player registration with leagues, OWHA & Hockey Canada as well as incidental fees to run the team and organization.

The Tier I fee will include everything that the Tier II fee includes as well as additional ice time.

The executive will work with the coaching staff of each team to determine which ice requirements will best fit each team's needs.

Evaluations

There will be a \$60 fee for evaluations. This fee is to cover ice costs for tryouts. If you choose to register with the Huron Heat, your tryout fee will be applied to the registration cost. If you choose not to register this fee will be considered non-refundable. Evaluations will be April 14, 17, 18, 20, 23, 24, and 30th. (Times posted on the Huron Heat website)

Each year there is a lot of work to organize the tryout process. It is important to have accurate numbers for this process to work efficiently. For this reason if you are choosing to have your child attend tryouts to be evaluated you need to check the box on the registration form.

When you have accepted a spot on a Huron Heat team a deposit of \$150 is required secure your spot. This deposit is non-refundable. You will have the opportunity to pay this fee at registration or after the evaluation skates. The remaining payments are to be submitted at the AGM. The date for the AGM will be in June. The \$150 deposit will be subtracted from the outstanding balance.

NOTES:

Only players that have registered/signed a tryout form and paid the tryout are permitted on the ice for tryouts.

Players that skated for any team other than the BCH Ice Stars, Blyth/Brussels Crusaders or West Huron Wave during the 2015/16 season will also be required to provide a permission to skate form.

Players that do not participate in the evaluation process will be placed on available teams at the discretion of the executive.

All players are encouraged to attend the evaluations.

Financial Assistance

It is the hope of the Huron Heat Female Hockey Association that any girl that wants to play hockey has that opportunity. If you require financial assistance to be able to do so please refer to our website http://www.huronheat.com for financial support programs offered. If you have further questions you can speak with a Huron Heat Girls Hockey Representative.

Fundraising

There will be fundraising ticket books at a value of \$100 per player to sell. There will be a maximum of 2 books per family.

Additionally each family will be required to sign up for a four hour volunteer shift per child at one of the organization's fundraiser activities to a maximum of eight hours per family. Sign up for these activities will occur at the registration and AGM. In order to ensure the volunteer hours are completed a \$200 postdated cheque for October 31, 2016 will be required as bond. If you choose not to fund raise at all, there will be a \$400 opt out fee.

If you are unable to pick up your tickets during registration it is your responsibility to arrange a time to pick them up.

All winning tickets must be properly filled out including full address to receive the cash prize.

Gate Fees

If your daughter is playing in Lower Lakes or WOGHL league there are no gate fees. The gate fee pays for the refs. Without gate fees the payment is required to be paid by the families involved. The gate fee is included in the base registration. If your daughter plays in a league that allows a gate fee to be charged you will receive a \$100 refund.

Late Fees

Any registration received after **May 31, 2016** from anyone attending evaluations will be subject to a \$150 late fee. The registration deadline for players not attending tryouts will be **April 18, 2016** and will be subject to the \$150 late fee. This is to allow the executive to have a better idea of the total number of registrations for the upcoming season.

Level of Play

Huron Heat Female Hockey Association offers teams for the skill level that is present. Our teams are entered in competitive leagues, tournaments and play downs. The Huron Heat is dedicated to creating a challenging environment focused on player development for all skill levels. It is our aim to provide multiple teams in each age division, thereby creating an opportunity for all female hockey players to play at a level that is suited to their abilities. The category for each team will be determined after the evaluation process has been completed.

Payment Options

Payment options are:

- 1) Full Payment on any of the dates listed below
- 2) Post Dated Cheque for; June 15, 2016, August 1, 2016, September 1, 2016 and October 1, 2016.

Cheques are to be made payable to Huron Heat Female Hockey Association

Any NSF cheque will be charged an additional \$25 per cheque.

Registration and fundraising must be paid in full by October 31, 2016 or the player's right to attend practices and games will be forfeited until such payment is made.

Reimbursement

Refunds will be granted according to the date the written application is received by Huron Heat Female Hockey Association at a pro-rated amount as decided by the executive. No refunds after December 1, 2016.

Miscellaneous

Throughout the season any division entering a tournament will do so as an extra cost not included in the registration fee.

Any volunteers that would like to take part in supporting a team on ice must be signed onto a volunteer list for insurance reasons. If interested in being on this list email make sure to check the volunteer box on the registration form.

Family Rate

First 2 children register at full price, a 50% discount applies to the base price for any additional girls from the same family registered with the Huron Heat. This discount does not apply to the fundamental program.
